

BMFC Registration and Competency Guidelines

Members with A certificates prior to 31/12/20 must:

- 1. Re-new their Operator ID** every 12 months with the CAA.
- 2. Log on to BMFA <u>Membership portal</u>, read and tick that they understand and have read Article 16 Authorisation.

(Note: If you have forgotten your Password then type your email address in the Username and click 'Forgotten Password'. If you have never registered then email <u>membership@bmfa.org</u> with your Name, Membership Number and Postcode and they will set you up.)

New Members after 31/12/20 must:

- 1. Register and pay for <u>Operator ID</u>** with CAA when they join the club.
- 2. Prior to taking the A test undertake and pass the <u>BMFA RCC</u>* test (Registration Competency Certificate).
- 3. Pass the A test with Club Examiner before flying solo.
- 4. Re-new their <u>Operator ID</u>** every 12 months with the CAA.
- 5. Re-new their BMFA RCC* with the BMFA every 5 years.

Members with valid A certificate prior to 31/12/20 who pass a further certificate (eq 'B' certificate) after 31/12/20 must:

- 1. Re-new their <u>Operator ID</u>** every 12 months with the CAA.
- 2. Optional Prior to taking the B test undertake and pass the <u>BMFA RCC</u>* test which will exempt you from being asked the mandatory questions after the practical test.
- 3. Undertake and pass the B test with two Club Examiners or Area Examiner. Answer Mandatory questions correctly if you do not have a valid RCC.

*You can take the CAA DMARES test instead of the BMFA RCC test, but you will be asked 5 (8 for B test) mandatory questions at the end of your practical. The DMARES test has to be re-taken every 3 years.

** CAA will issue reminders when Operator ID renewal is due. This can be undertaken direct with the CAA or through the BMFA Membership Portal
